The Door County Board of Supervisors does hereby ordain an amendment to Chapter 4.17 Door County Code as follows:

1 **C. COSTS for purposes of prisoner reimbursement to the county are:**

2 1. Processing fee of twenty-seven dollars and fifty cents (\$27.50) ~~twenty-~~

3 ~~five dollars (\$25.00)~~ per incident.

4 2. Full per person maintenance and cost of "Huber Law" prisoner's board is

5 fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per day.

6 3. Actual per-day cost of maintaining prisoner in ordinary confinement is:

7 a. ten dollars (\$10.00) for the first day and

8 b. five dollars (\$5.00) for each subsequent day.

9 4. Medical Expenses paid by County for prisoner.

11 This amendatory ordinance shall take effect immediately following publication.

14 does not conflict with the provisions herein.
