1 The Door County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Section 59.69(5)(e).,  
2 Wisconsin Statutes, does hereby ordain amendments to Sections 2.02(h)  
3 and 2.03(1) as follows:

4  
5 2.02(h). The mapped Wetland zoning district boundaries  
6 coincide with the wetland boundaries shown on the most  
7 recent version of the Wisconsin Wetland Inventory maps for  
8 Door County which have been prepared by the Wisconsin  
9 Department of Natural Resources. Where an apparent  
10 discrepancy exists between a Wetland district boundary as  
11 shown on the zoning map or Wisconsin Wetland Inventory  
12 maps and actual field conditions for a permit application  
13 project site, the Zoning Administrator shall contact the  
14 appropriate office of the Department of Natural Resources to  
15 determine if the boundary as mapped is in error. If the  
16 Department of Natural Resources staff concur with the  
17 Zoning Administrator that a particular area was incorrectly  
18 mapped as a wetland or non-wetland, the Zoning  
19 Administrator may immediately grant or deny appropriate  
20 permits in accordance with the regulations applicable to the  
21 correct base zoning district. The Zoning Administrator and  
22 Resource Planning Committee shall subsequently initiate a  
23 zoning map amendment to correct these mapping  
24 discrepancies.

26 Delete existing 2.03(1) "Commentary" section.

28 Pursuant to Section 59.69(5)(e)6., Wisconsin Statutes, this ordinance  
29 shall become effective upon passage.
