## AMENDMENT TO THE COUNTY ZONING MAP OF UNION CHAUDOIRS DOCK, LLC

The Door County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Section 59.69(5)(e)., Wisconsin Statutes, does hereby ordain an amendment to the County's detailed zoning map to the Town of Union to change the zoning district classification of the following parcel from High Density Residential (HD) to Recreational Commercial (RC):

A parcel of land located in Government Lot 1 of Section 10, Town 26 North, Range 23 East Town of Union, Door County, Wisconsin bounded and described as follows; Commencing at the southwest corner of said Government Lot 1; thence North 00° 40′ 04" east 531.53 feet along the west line of said Government Lot 1; thence North 34° 22′ 22" East 815.46 feet; thence South 67° 04′ 16" East 248.33 feet; thence North 10° 30′ 11" East 161.20 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 71° 08′ 06" West 34.40 feet; thence North 18° 51′ 54" East 35.39 feet; thence South 68° 29′ 49" East 13.88 feet; thence North 21° 30′ 11" West 80.00 feet; thence South 10° 30′ 11" West to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains approximately 1,742 square feet.

Pursuant to Section 59.69(5)(e)6., Wisconsin Statutes, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
