1 **WHEREAS**, In 1999, the Wisconsin Legislature directed, by
2 enactment of Section 84.106 Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin
3 Department of Transportation to develop, implement and administer a
4 scenic byways program; *and*

6 **WHEREAS**, This statute also directed the Department of
7 Transportation to promulgate rules [i.e., Chapter Trans 202 Wisconsin
8 Administrative Code] for the program consistent with 23 U.S.C. 162 and
9 regulations established there under; *and*

11 **WHEREAS**, The stated purpose of the scenic byways program is to
12 identify, designate, promote and preserve state trunk highways with
13 outstanding scenic, historic, cultural, natural, recreational or
14 archeological qualities as scenic byways; *and*

16 **WHEREAS**, A coalition of local units of government in Door County
17 is contemplating the submission of a multi-jurisdiction application for
18 designation of State Trunk Highways 42 and 57 ["subject road"] in Door
19 County, Wisconsin as a State Scenic Byway; *and*

21 **WHEREAS**, In unincorporated areas where Door County Zoning is
22 in effect, this application must also contain a resolution from the Door
23 County Board of Supervisors supporting the request; *and*

25 **WHEREAS**, There is no fiscal, or other, impact associated with the
26 Door County's support of this request.

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Door County
29 Board of Supervisors does hereby express its support and request
30 approval for the designation of the subject road as a Wisconsin State
31 Scenic Byway.


