1 **WHEREAS**, The Office of Energy Independence was created by Governor  
2 Doyle on April 5th, 2007 with the mission to advance energy independence in the  
3 State of Wisconsin; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin's "25X25 Goals" include:

- Generating 25% of Wisconsin's electricity and transportation fuels from  
7 renewable resources by 2025.
- Capturing 10% of the emerging bioindustry and renewable energy market  
8 by 2030.
- Leading the nation in groundbreaking research that will make renewable  
9 energy more affordable and will create good paying Wisconsin jobs; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin's Energy Independent Community ["EI"] Partnership  
14 contemplates voluntary agreements between the Office of Energy Independence  
15 and Wisconsin communities. The first step toward this partnership is a community's  
16 adoption of a resolution in support of the "25x25 Goals". and

18 **WHEREAS**, EI Community partnership benefits include:

- Additional access to state and federal funding.
- Increased technical assistance from state and federal agencies.
- Improved energy efficiency creating additional savings and capital  
20 availability for budgeting.
- Moving the energy independence message of hope and opportunity to  
21 Door County, Wisconsin residents who choose to be part of this vision; and

26 **WHEREAS**, EI Community partnership is purely voluntary and does not  
27 obligate the County to take any particular action or appropriate funds for any  
28 purpose.

30 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Door County Board of  
31 Supervisors hereby expresses its support for, and commitment to advance,  
32 Wisconsin's vision for energy independence including the "25x25 GOALS".

34 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That County Administrator Serpe and County  
35 Board Chairman Zipperer are directed to appoint a "25 x 25 EI Goals Ad Hoc  
36 Committee" to:

- develop and make recommendations to the Property Committee with  
38 respect to efforts to advance energy independence within Door County and
- coordinate and support those efforts approved by the Property Committee  
39 and/or County Board.
