




1 **WHEREAS**, The U.S. Department of Navy will issue a solicitation
 2 to procure up to ten [10] Littoral Combat Ships (LCS) in FY2010
 3 through FY2014; and

 5 **WHEREAS**, Marinette Marine Corporation of Marinette,
 6 Wisconsin is an integral part of an industry team led by Lockheed
 7 Martin Corporation that is competing for award of the U.S. Navy's
 8 upcoming LCS Project contract; and

 10 **WHEREAS**, The economic impact of the U.S. Navy's LCS project
 11 contract is significant. Each LCS built will yield direct and significant
 12 benefits to Wisconsin and Michigan by creating and sustaining jobs
 13 and will result in a \$450,000,000 contribution to the economy; and


