Unofficial Minutes of the Door County Fair Board Officers and the Facilities and Parks Committee

April 16th, 2019

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Vice President Thad Ash. This in attendance include: Aaron Ash, Tim Ash, Sara Mueller, Jeremy Schopf, Dawn VandeVoort, Steve Jennerjohn, John White, Bill Forry, and Laura Viles. Tom Ash was not present. A motion was made to amend the order of agenda items, moving Fairest of the Fair up in the order, and to pass the minutes of the March meeting by John White. A second by Steve. Motion Carried.
2. Fairest of the Fairs coordinator, Laura, updated the board on current happenings with the fairest. She will be attending the Brussels Easter Egg Hunt on April 20th with eggs stuffed with Fair information. This is currently one applicant for 2019 fairest. The deadline is April 24th. Even with one applicant, the selection process will still continue. There is hope for a crowing celebration for this year's fairest. Laura is looking to bring in artist to create art at the fair. A motion was made by Steve to allow lifetime entry for all Door County Fairests. Motion second by John. Motion carried.
3. Bill Forry reported on the discussion his group had on the topic of stand fees. Steve motioned to increase stand fees by \$500 (bringing them to \$1700) which will include 10 booster buttons for each stand. Second by John. Motion carried. All fee recommendations will be presented to the Facilities and Parks Committee at the May meeting.
4. Tim and Jeremy talked about sponsorships. There are feelers out, however it is still early.
5. For contracts, we are just waiting on the BMX and woodcarver contracts to be signed and returned. The ATM called and confirmed the dates with Thad. Tim talked about the plans with Paperboy and the Pulse – both are within \$5 of last year's contracts. Tim is going to talk with Door County Daily News. Tom will reach out to WDOR. John has been in contact with the Cinema. For the next meeting, we are looking for insight on Ticket King with Keith Anderson. In preparation for Keith Anderson quotes from Green Bay stations will be sought.
6. Next Meeting is May 16th in the Chambers Room with the request of the presence of the Facilities and Park Committee members to go over fee recommendations. It will begin at 6:30 pm.
7. A motion to adjourn was made by Sara, second by John. Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:26 pm.
