

As a condition of being an active participant in the following Forest Tax program:

Open **Managed Forest Law** (MFL) – allows public hunting, fishing, hiking, sight-seeing, and cross-country skiing; and

Open **Forest Crop Law** (FCL) – allows public hunting and fishing.

- Active lands may not include the owners' entire parcel.
- Unauthorized motorized vehicle traffic is NOT allowed on lands.
- It is recommended that the owner(s) be contacted prior to planning an activity on MFL or FCL lands.

To view active lands in the DNR Forestry Program from the [Door County Web Map](#) ( <http://map.co.door.wi.us/map/> ), go to the Layers Tab, open folder "Cultural/Recreation" and check on layer "Managed Forest Lands". To get information on a particular parcel that may be partially or entirely active in the open MFL or FCL, use the "Identify" tool to select a point within the desired parcel. The Information tab will then include Forest Law detail specific to the parcel, including program type, approximate acreage, owner name and address.
