Door County Parks Seasonal Workers

Short term positions available May through August annually

Long term positions available Spring thru Fall annually

Work schedules may vary depending on the position and maybe less than 40 hours a week. Weather conditions may also reduce hours per week.

Starting Wage: \$11.50/hour - Must be 18 years of age

- **Cleaning positions** ~ Four 10 hour days, 5 a.m. to 3 p.m.
Two Shifts - Sunday thru Wednesday or Wednesday thru Saturday
- **Mowing positions** ~ Four 10+ hour days (40 hour max/week)
Monday thru Thursday with Friday as a rain day
- **Maintenance positions** ~ Five 8+ hour days (40 hour max/week)
Monday thru Friday
- **Security positions** ~ P.M. Shifts ~ hours vary
Two person position encompassing 7 days a week.

A brief description of the Job Functions:

Cleaning position

- Clean restrooms & park buildings
- Wash walls, picnic tables, & signs
- Clean grills & debris off launch ramps
- Empty garbage cans; walk through parks picking up garbage & sticks.
- Monitor boat launch operations within the parks: pick up fees & issue tickets
- Landscaping work: pulling weeds, raking, picking stones, seeding grass, etc.
- Truck washing and waxing

Mowing position

- Transport mowers and equipment to various parks.
- Ground maintenance activities: primarily mowing lawns and string trimming various parks and trails.
- Landscaping duties to include but not limited to: pulling weeds, raking, picking stones, seeding grass, planting trees, fertilizing, filling holes, mixing and spraying weed killer, etc.
- Responsible for maintaining equipment: change blades, grease, check for broken parts, check radiator, check/change belts, etc.
- Change tires on mowers, trailers and trucks.
- Power wash & clean equipment

Maintenance position

- Performs minor maintenance on trucks and mowers.
- Inspects parks and facilities for cleanliness and safety.
- Performs ground maintenance and planting activities.
- Paints and performs structural repairs to masonry, woodwork and furnishing of buildings.
- Build and assemble equipment or facilities such as chain or wooden fences, shelters, picnic tables, park benches including mixing and pouring of cement, etc.
- Assist with Dock system installation and removal in April and October.

Security position

- Monitor Security in County Parks.
- Monitor Boat Launches and insure compliance with Park policies.
- Observe after dark operation of facilities.
