**Japanese Knotweed** is an aggressive, bamboo-like, exotic species that can cause serious costly structural damage with its rhizomes.

Do you know how to identify this plant, as it may impact your property value?

There's not much information on the best way to control **Japanese knotweed**. DCIST is working in conjunction with a contractor and the Sturgeon Bay City Parks in an experiment to find the most effective ways to remove knotweed.
