LANDOWNER/COST-SHARE RECIPIENT IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION COST-SHARING POLICY

Landowner/Cost-share Recipient In-Kind contributions to the installation/construction of a best management practice shall be cost-shared if the activity directly relates to the installation/construction of the practice. Activities which may be indirectly necessiated by the installation/construction of the practice, which are not directly related to the actual installation/construction of the practice, shall be considered noncost-shareable contributions.

Cost-share calculations shall be based on the hourly rates for landowner/cost-share recipient labor and equipment adopted by the Land Conservation Committee. In-kind contributions not included on the adopted rates list shall be cost-shared at rates which are the lowest cost rate or material available, if supplied by a source other than the landowner/cost-share recipient. The cost-shared rate shall be the lower of a comparison of bid prices received for the same tasks and actual hours claimed by the landowner/cost-share recipient. In-Kind contributions for labor shall not exceed that which is considered reasonable and/or customary for a given task.
